Outdoor & Indoor Pool Usage Agreement

When using the swimming pools, please read the rules and regulations, check each box, sign, and submit this form to our pool reception.

- Entry is not permitted for anyone affiliated with organized crime groups.
- Access to the pool facilities may be restricted for guests with tattoos.
- Guests who are unwell, experiencing diarrhea or vomiting, or who are heavily intoxicated are not permitted to use the pool.
- Alcohol purchases are limited to two drinks per person. (Alcohol will not be sold to guests under 20 years old. Age verification may be required.)
- Operating hours and services may change or be suspended due to natural disasters or maintenance. We kindly ask for your understanding.
- Taking photos or videos of other guests without permission is prohibited. When using smartphones or other devices, please be considerate of other guests.
- Children under 4 years old, as well as guests who have not completed their potty training are not allowed to enter the pool for safety reasons. Swim diapers are also not allowed. (Access to the poolside area is permitted.)
- For safety reasons, please remove accessories such as watches, necklaces, earrings, and other valuables before swimming.
- Guests wearing highly revealing swimwear may be asked to refrain from using the pool.
- Smoking is prohibited throughout the facility.
- Please refrain from bringing the following items:
 1. Food and alcoholic beverages (non-alcoholic drinks in water bottles and plastic water bottles are permitted)
 2. Dangerous items, glassware, glass bottles (including baby bottles), sharp objects, blades, ignition sources, toxic or hazardous substances
 3. Floats larger than 90 cm in diameter, picnic blankets, beach mats, beach balls, water guns, parasols, tents, snorkels, fins, diving masks, and audio equipment
- In accordance with public health regulations, entry will be refused to the following guests:
 1. Guests who have fungal infections, pyogenic infection, skin diseases, or other contagious illnesses
 2. Guests who have fever, conjunctivitis, or laryngitis
 3. Guests who are wearing bandages
- Guests engaging in violent or disruptive behavior toward other guests will be asked to leave.
- First aid will be provided for injuries occurring in the pool, but the hotel cannot accept further responsibility.
- The hotel is not responsible for any conflicts between guests.
- For safety reasons, please follow all instructions given by staff while in the pool.
