

Kumanokoutaijinja (Shrine)

Situated at an elevation of 1,200 meters (3,937 feet), this unusual shrine's grounds are split down the middle by the border dividing Nagano and Gunma Prefectures. To the left behind the Honden main shrine is a 1.000-year-old Japanese linden tree, considered a sacred Shinto tree thought to bring good fortune and success in matchmaking endeavors.


