

Architectures in Japanese Garden



The Kihinkan
貴賓館

Completed in 1911, as Prince Takedanomiya's residence. Designed by Toukuma Katayama.



EAN Japanese Tea House
茶寮 惠庵

Design by Togo Murano in 1985.



Kannondo
観音堂

Removed from Chokyu-ji (Nara Pref.) and reconstructed in 1954.



Pair of Stone Guardian Dog
狛犬

Made in 18th century. Removed from Shinagawa Prince Hotel and reconstructed in 1990.



Temple Gate / Bronze Lantern
山門・青銅灯籠

The architect and the history of the gate are unknown. Bronze Lantern was in graveyard of General Tokugawa.



Bell Tower
鐘楼

Made in 1656. Removed from Nenbutsu-ji (Nara Pref.) and reconstructed in 1959.
